

## How Do I Pick A Realtor In Tucson Az?

### 1. Decide What You Need

- Communication style — Do they respond promptly? Are they easy to contact?
- Marketing plan (if selling) — How will they advertise and promote your home?

### 5. Ask the Right Questions

- How many years they've worked in Tucson

- How they'll **communicate** with you — phone, text, email, frequency

Good communication is essential — a top agent will keep you informed at every step.

### 6. Review Credentials & Specialties

Many realtors hold designations that show extra training:

- **ABR** – Accredited Buyer's Representative
  - **CRS** – Certified Residential Specialist
  - **SRS** – Seller Representative Specialist
- This can indicate strengths in a specific area (buyers, sellers, seniors, luxury homes, etc.).

### 7. Trust Your Instincts

You'll be working closely with this person, sometimes over weeks or months — so choose someone you feel comfortable with, who listens, and communicates well.
